ABOUT THE WORKSHOP:

National workshop on Soft Computing is very relevant in the present scenario as more complex systems arising in biology medicine, the humanities, management sciences, and similar fields often remained intractable to conventional mathematical and analytical methods. Early computational systems could model and precisely analyse only relatively simple systems.

Soft computing deals with imprecision, uncertainty, partial truth, and approximation to achieve practability, robustness and low solution cost. Components of soft computing include: Neural Networks, Fuzzy systems, Evolutionary Computation, Swarm Intelligence, Chaos theory and perception and ideas about probability.

Unlike hard computing schemes, which strive for exactness and full truth, soft computing techniques exploit the given tolerance of imprecision, partial truth, and uncertainty for a particular problem. Another common contrast comes from the observation that inductive reasoning plays a larger role in soft computing than in hard computing.
